The City of Moss Point gives notice that information relative to the planning, development and implementation of it's 2019 Annual Action Plan Component, available and proposed use of funding as required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is available for review. The City of Moss Point is an entitlement city and expects to receive \$107,688 in CDBG Entitlement funds for the 2019 program year. The City does not receive entitlement funding for HOME, ESG OR HOPWA.
